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for a first reading. With no one else present, the public comment period was closed at 9:20.

Daniel Schwarz joined the meeting by cell phone. He is the one that will be working on a grant through the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Community program. This grant provides federal funding for hazardous mitigation projects to the tune of 75% with the City covering 25% of the costs. Mr. Schwarz said he needs a list of projects which are to be prioritized in order of importance.

The update on the Legion was the lease agreement for the KMM building has been signed with the collection of a deposit and first month's rent. The Legion had requested for an amendment of an option to purchase or lease renewal if the Legion did not have purchase money at the end of the lease. They were also requesting that any moneys paid during the lease period be applied to the purchase price. Mayor Lindquist said he told them the City was not interested in any amendments to the agreement and if the Legion is still unable to purchase the building at the end of six months, there would not be an extension. The Council agreed the sole purpose of the lease was to give the Legion time to come up with the purchase money.

The broken water line has been fixed and

Mr. Lindquist will work with Mr. Roehl on the needed cleaning.

The Council asked Tricia Schalesky to join the meeting again to discuss the custodial contract. The City asked Mrs. Schalesky which of two options would she like – option 1 is to renew the contract as is or option 2 is to open the contract back up for bidding with the additional duty of managing the fitness center. She said she would like option 2. The Council agreed to have Mayor Lindquist, Council member Michele Gaylord and Mrs. Schalesky put together a job description of duties and responsibilities prior to re-posting the position. The Council approved having the auditor advertise the Rebid Custodial Contract.

In the approval of bills Mr. Ebert asked if the City had really ordered six new water meters and why. Auditor Krista Faller said Burlington Northern Santa Fe railroad apparently does not heat the room where the meter is located so when the weather gets cold the plastic housing breaks. This has happened three times now. It is City ordinance that if a water meter breaks due to negligence of the business, the business is billed for the cost of the meter plus 8 percent. The Council approved the paying of the bills as the final action of the meeting.
