WEATHER FORECAST



This week temperatures will be well above seasonal averages and only slight chances for precipitation. Gusty winds will be a recurring theme through the weekend before easing somewhat early next week.

Thursday, May 28: The forecast calls for a warm and breezy day with partly cloudy skies. High temperatures will climb to around 88 before dropping to 61 overnight.

Friday, May 29: Conditions remain nearly unchanged as partly cloudy skies and persistent winds contin-

ue. Afternoon highs will reach 84 with an overnight low near 60.

Saturday, May 30: A slightly cooler day arrives with a high near 80 and a low of 58. Partly cloudy skies will prevail, although a weak disturbance could bring a few isolated showers. The chance of precipitation increases to 24 percent.

Sunday, May 31: Pleasant late-spring weather continues with partly cloudy skies and a high around 80. Overnight temperatures will dip to 55.

Monday, June 1: The new month begins with comfortable

temperatures and partly cloudy conditions. Highs will top out near 79 with a low of 54. A slight chance of a passing shower exists, with precipitation chances near 22 percent.

Tuesday, June 2: Expect another mild and mostly dry day. Afternoon temperatures will reach 79 while overnight lows settle near 53. Rain chances remain low at 20 percent.

Wednesday, June 3: The forecast wraps up on a warm note with highs returning to the lower 80s. Overnight lows will fall to 53 under partly cloudy skies.

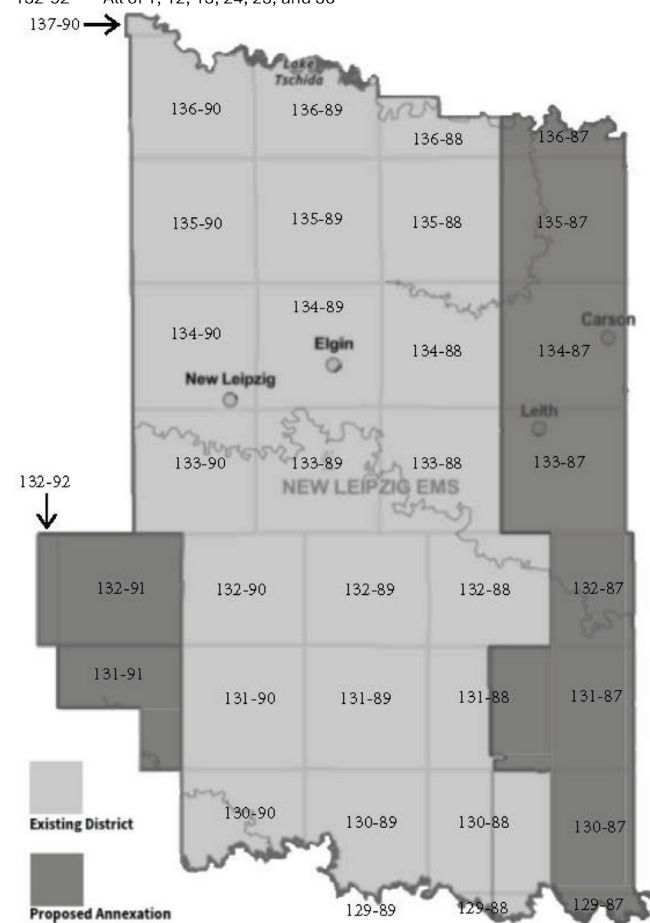
