BUDGET MEETING**

The Board of Commission held a special meeting for 2027 Budget work. Commission Chair Dustin Laufer called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. Commissioner Laufer, Commissioner West and Commissioner Pagel were in attendance.

AGENDA: Commissioner Pagel moved to approve the agenda for the special meeting, second by Commissioner West, and by unanimous vote; motion carried.

2027 BUDGET: Discussion was had on upcoming road projects and federal funding in the next year, as well as the 911 re-addressing for rural Adams County. Tax Director, Katie Roseland, met with the Commission to discuss her 2026 budget (current year budget) as she is having server issues with her Vanguard CAMA system. The server is 4 years old and needs to be replaced, the quote for the new server is \$2,185.00.

Ms. Roseland is able to relocate items within her budget to cover the cost of the new server. Commissioner West moved to approve the new server, second by Commissioner Pagel, and by unanimous vote; motion carried. Increases budgeted were 4% with larger increase for Head Librarian and Sheriff Office Deputy. The Road Dept salaries were set at 4% with restrictions held for Road Superintendent and employees without a CDL. A review and appropriations to the road and bridge budget were completed. State's Attorney, Aaron Roseland, met with the Commission to re-discuss his departmental budget.

Budget Hearing date for 2027 budget: September 8, 2026, at 1 pm

ADJOURN: Commissioner Pagel moved to adjourn, second by Commissioner West, and by unanimous vote, motion carried. Commission Chair Dustin Laufer declared the meeting adjourned at 5:26 p.m.
