There, you will see when your ballot was mailed to you. Until your ballot is received by the auditor's office, the status will show "Status Unknown." When your ballot is received, the date will appear next to "Ballot Returned Date."

Ballot measure

A measure asking voters to consider appointment rather than election of the state's attorney will also appear on the ballot.

The measure states:

"The Grant County State's Attorney position has gone unfilled via election, and the Grant County Commission wishes to change the position to appointed rather than elected. Accordingly, to allow the Grant County Commission to select the best candidate through competitive hiring practices to act as the Grant County State's Attorney, should the position be changed from an elected office to an appointed office as allowed under

N.D.C.C § 11-10-02.3? If the voters approve this change, the Grant County State's Attorney would be appointed by the Grant County Commission through competitive hiring."

Even with a state's attorney candidate on the June ballot for the first time in over a decade, passage of this measure means the position will be appointed, explained the current state's attorney, Grant Walker.

The measure will pass with a simple majority vote and would go into effect Jan. 1, 2027.
