BOARD MINUTES FLASHER PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 39 REGULAR MEETING – MAY 12, 2026

The regular meeting of the board was called to order on the above date at 7:08 P.M. by President Travis Rossow with the following present: Directors Nancy Malm, Joe Fleck, Sherry Schmidt, CJ Boldt, Duric Hoff (via telephone), Supt. JR Wilson, Principals Jamie Krenz and Brian Nieuwsma, and Business Manager Joyce Miller. Director Andrea Fleck was unable to attend. Visitors were Jennifer Zingg, Katie Gross, Sam Poland, Kacey Isbell, Sheyna Strommen, Vicki Krenz, and Tasha Bohl.

Minutes of the regular meeting of April 15, 2026 were presented. Motion by Schmidt, second by J. Fleck, to approve the minutes after corrections were noted. Motion carried with all voting aye.

Financial Reports of the General Fund, Building Fund, Hot Lunch and Activity Funds were presented and reviewed by the board. Motion by Malm, second by J. Fleck, to approve reports as presented. Motion carried with all voting aye.

Transportation: summer maintenance on the buses will be starting when school is over; the committee will meet in June; open positions are activity driver and one route driver.

Building & Grounds: summer maintenance is being compiled by Supt. Wilson and Derek Rich (head of maintenance); existing playground equipment needs some repair-having trouble locating replacement parts; grant money could be used to

purchase additional pieces-two quotes have been received for equipment. Discussion. Motion by CJ, second by Malm, to install & purchase new playground equipment from Wiley-Goat for \$39,178.00 (installation included in that price). Motion carried with all voting aye. Football bleachers will be dug into hill and a retaining wall installed; 4-5" of asphalt will be installed on June 8 on the road north side of the bleachers to the football fence.

Motion by J. Fleck, second by Schmidt, to approve after the second reading of AAC-BR2 Title IX. Motion carried with all voting aye.

Meeting recessed at 7:46. Reconvened at 7:50.

Principals Krenz & Nieuwsma reported on: enrollment of 243 K-12; ND A+ spring summative & interim testing was completed on May 8; onboarding of new staff and teacher in service is underway; Title I School Wide reports due June 15; ND Choice Ready due June 30; Continuous School Improvement Strategy Map is due September 1; May 18 will be a day for end of year work & Infinite Campus training; FFA events-horse judging on May 5; state convention is June 1; Business Dept.-entrepreneur students had a successful Lemonade Day; Vision Zero conference-Brenna Eckroth was one of the speakers; teacher appreciation week; Theo Art School day; KG/Sr hall walk; first graders captured the Alphabet Bandit; Mor-Gran-Sou poster contest winners; 2025-26 yearbooks for sale; elementary, junior high, & high school spring events include: spring concert, field day, Earth Day, wax museum; kindergarten

graduation on May 13; ND Academic All-State team; Best of the Class; ISEF Science Fair May 11-15, semester tests, graduation May 17.

Brian Nieuwsma gave an athletic director update: 2026-27 activities scheduling; gym floor refinishing scheduled; Alumni volleyball game July 17; track & field update; boys' golf; Winter Sports Awards April 27; All School Awards Banquet May 6; gearing up for volleyball & football start dates.

Supt. Wilson reported on: staffing for next year; virtual class offerings guidance; 4-day school week-surveys to the students, parents, and community; J-1 Visa info.

Motion by Schmidt, second by Malm, to approve the Health & Safety Plan after updates and is posted on the website. Motion carried with all voting aye.

Motion by J. Fleck, second by Schmidt, to have the superintendent file the Title I Intent to Apply Application and to co-mingle the funds. Motion carried with all voting aye.

Motion by Schmidt, second by J. Fleck to approve the following policies after the first reading-ABBDA-Political Activities; ACCA-Sexual Offender School Property; FF-Student Conduct and Discipline. Motion by Schmidt, second by Boldt, to approve after the first reading FFE-Extracurricular Participation with changes. Motions carried with all voting aye.

Motion by J. Fleck, second by Boldt, to approve the elementary teaching contract for Samantha Berger in the amount of \$44,200.00. Motion carried with all voting aye.

Motion by J. Fleck, second by Schmidt, to offer the principals' contracts with a \$1500.00 raise for the 2026-27 school year. Motion carried with all voting aye.
