


The deadline for applying for the 2026 spring turkey season is Feb. 11.

considered for the NDSU interim presidency. It is expected that this interim appointment will continue until the permanent president is hired, likely in late spring 2026.

Berg said, "It's an honor to serve North Dakota State University in this role. NDSU has shaped so many lives across our state, including my own, and I'm grateful for the opportunity to support our students, faculty, and staff during this transition. Together, we will continue advancing the mission and momentum of this great university."

Berg brings a longstanding commitment to North Dakota and broad leadership experience that spans public service, business, and community engagement. He served for many years in the North Dakota House of Representatives and later represented the state in the U.S. House of Representatives, gaining a deep understanding of public stewardship and collaborative leadership.

Outside of public service, Berg has built a career in real estate and development. He is a founder and partner of Great States Development, Great States Construction, and Collective, and has been actively involved in economic development and civic organizations across the Fargo-Moorhead region, including the Fargo Cass County Economic Development Corporation, the North Dakota Chamber of Commerce, and United Way. He has also been a longtime supporter of NDSU, supporting student scholarships through Bison Bidders Bowl and Bison Athletics through Team Makers. A native of Hettinger, North Dakota, Berg earned a bachelor's degree in agricultural economics from NDSU. He and his wife, Tracy, have one child.
