MILNOR CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING
MONDAY, MARCH 9, 2026 - 5 P.M.

At a regular meeting of the Milnor City Council held on Monday, March 9, 2026, 5:00 p.m. the following members were present: Curtis Anderson, Denise Ferderer, Glen Koeppe, Michelle Odegard, Jodi Ost and Jasmine Smith. Also present: Carol Peterson, LeeAnn Even, Scott Johnson, Rick Bryant, Olivia Case, Tracy Lien, Ryan Smith, Terry Dusek and Jennie Hanna. Paul Ellefson joined the meeting later.

Meeting called to order by Mayor, Terry Dusek.

Motion to approve meeting agenda (Ost/Odegard, unanimous).

Motion to approve February meeting minutes (Anderson/Ferderer, unanimous).

Tracy Lien was in attendance to receive approval from council to cut the cement in front of the Veteran's Hall, in order to allow for better water drainage. The sidewalk gets icy when the water accumulates. John Buskohl would do the work, and he would cut the cement and install a grate over it.

Motion to approve allowing the Veteran's Hall to have the sidewalk cut and a grate installed for better water drainage (Ost/Koeppe, unanimous).

Ryan Smith reviewed the Maintenance Report and presented two quotes to council, one for the debris blower Bobcat attachment for \$7499 and for a Hydra Bucket to break up ice for \$7750.

Motion to approve purchasing both equipment items (Ost/Ferderer, unanimous).

A quote of \$995.00 for a new laptop for the shop was also presented.

Motion to approve purchasing a new shop laptop (Anderson/Ost, unanimous).

LeeAnn Even reviewed the Attorney's Report and discussed the floodplain ordinance with council. She stated that the city being under the county's umbrella is not an option. Even informed council she recommended adopting the ordinance. The first reading of the ordinance was completed.

Motion to adopt the floodplain ordinance (Ost/Koeppe, unanimous).

Deputy Rick Bryant reviewed the Sheriff's report and informed council about ongoing issues within the city and stated there are trials coming up for some of the bigger cases.

Carol Peterson reviewed the Economic Development Report and updated council about current grants. Peterson informed council the flower pots had been ordered for the Satellite Club and discussed adding tree information to the city's website.

Paul Ellefson was in attendance to answer council questions regarding the issue of corn chaff emitted by the elevator. Ellefson stated he is not aware of a filter or any suitable solution to prevent or lessen the chaff. He stated the elevator hires people in the fall to specifically clean up the chaff, as best they can. Because it was a high volume year, and the drying season was longer, more chaff was in the air. Council questioned why other elevators in cities don't have the same problem, but Ellefson stated they have the same issue. Ellefson agreed to research further solutions and stated he doesn't like the mess it creates either.

Motion to approve a building permit for Jeff Halmrast - new windows (Koeppe/Ferderer, unanimous).

Motion to approve a building permit for Milnor Grain - three new bins on south side of elevator (Odegard/Koeppe, unanimous).

Motion to approve gaming permit - Milnor School Europe Trip - raffle (Ferderer/Smith, unanimous).

Council discussed the truck route through the city, and which streets should have No Truck signs. Mayor Dusek stated that drivers will need to be re-educated regarding using the city's truck route, which is Main Street. Member Koeppe agreed to take a map to the elevator which will highlight the city's truck route.

Mayor Dusek discussed the upcoming election and informed council he will not be seeking another term as mayor. The following bills were presented and approved (Ost/Odegard, unanimous).
