The School Board of Milnor Public School, District No. 2, met for their regular monthly meeting on Monday, June 22, 2026, at 5:00 pm in the ITV Room. The Pledge of Allegiance was said. The board reviewed the poll book from elections and canvassed the results. Bogart moved to approve the election results of Krista Bussman and Betsy Speich, Wehlander seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Mrs. Weber presented her yearly BARR data.

Mund moved to approve the 25-26 Pupil Membership Report, Bogart seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Wehlander moved to approve the sale of the red van for \$3,000, Mund seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Bogart moved to approve the tuition agreement from an incoming kindergarten student from Enderlin School District, Wehlander seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

We have submitted yearly grant funds, but they won't come in before next payroll cycle. We are also tighter than expected in reserve funds this year. Loan should be paid off in October after we receive grant funds plus our first state aid payment next school year. Wehlander moved to approve a short-term loan in the amount of \$500,000, Mund seconded. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
