It was a tough week for the Raiders facing two teams receiving votes in the state rankings. First up was the New-Rockford Sheyenne Rockets on January 27 in Drake. Down by 13 after the first quarter, the Raiders rallied and only let the Rockets outscore them by three in the next two quarters, helped in part by junior Brady Lageson's 12 second quarter points. Unfortunately, the Raiders ran out of gas in the fourth quarter, allowing the NR-S lead to grow from 16 at the end of the third to 35 at the final buzzer.
